Assist with mowing and trimming shrubbery; occasional housekeeping and cleaning tasks; cook and prepare meals for gatherings and meals-on-wheels; assist with clean-up after fellowship dinners; provide snacks for the coffee hour on Sunday mornings.

Media Technologies

Help maintain and manage social media accounts for the church; create video and audio presentations for church staff and committees; operate the sound system in the traditional service or the sound and video in the contemporary service.

Organize and coordinate learning opportunities for adults; coordinate activities such as Parent's Night Out, Christmas Pageant, Picnic-on-the-Grounds; help with Vacation Bible School; Lead a Bible study group; write Christian Education articles for Windows or other church publications; serve as a mentor for a teen in the Confirmation Class; drive a van to out-of-town teen activities (must be over 25 with clean driving record).

Safety and Security

Monitor various areas of the church as needed to maintain safety and security; help develop, design, and manage security and safety standards.

Worship

Serve as an usher or greeter; be a part of the worship team to help lead the contemporary service.

Music

Sing or play an instrument during the traditional or contemporary service; assist with children's choral activities.

Discipleship

Prepare/serve food for family of deceased members; visit shut-in members and others to provide compassionate care for those unable to attend church functions; deliver meals to shut-in members; monitor hospital admissions and schedule visits for pastoral staff.
